About Lt. Moinul Hoque Choudhury



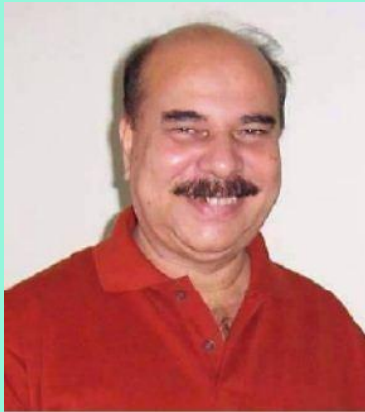
Moinul Hoque Choudhury was born on 13 May 1923 in a well known family of Sonabarighat in the Cachar district of Assam. He was born to mother Mona Bibi and father Montajir Ali. He took his primary education from M.E. School of Sonabraighat. He passed Matriculation from Silchar Government H.S. School and later joined Cotton College, Guwahati / Murari Chand College of Sylhet and passed intermediate in 1942.

He graduated with History Honours from Presidency College of Kolkata in 1944. In the Presidency College, he defeated Sheikh Mujibur Rahman in the college election. He pursued M.A. in History securing first class first position from Aligarh Muslim University in 1946. He also took part in the Indian Independence Movement. In 1947, he obtained LLB from Aligarh Muslim University. Inspired by the ideas of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose and Moulana Abul Kalam Azad, Mr. Moinul Hoque joined the freedom struggle. Following India's independence and the partition of India, he joined Indian National Congress under the influence of Fakaruddin Ali Ahmed.

To start his career, Moinul Hoque Choudhury joined the Bar Association of Silchar in 1948 and later in 1950, he joined active politics as a member of local board in 1950 and was a nominated member of Silchar Municipality in the same year. He became a member of Assam Legislative Assembly in 1952 from East Sonai constituency. Moinul Hoque became a cabinet minister (agriculture) in 1957 after being elected for the second time from the same constituency. On being elected for the third term in 1962, he became the leader of the Congress Legislature in the assembly in addition to being a cabinet minister. In 1967 he was elected for the fourth time as MLA from Sonai Constituency, but was abstained from ministerial portfolio following a feud with Bimala Prasad Chaliha. He was selected as chairman of National Haj Committee in the same year. He entered the national politics in 1971 by returning to the parliament from Dhubri as MP and was offered the Ministry of Industry under the Government of India.

The establishment of All India Radio, Silchar Medical College, Veterinary School, Cachar Paper Mill at Panchgram, Sugar Mill at Anipur, the Regional Engineering College now upgraded as NIT are his achievements. He was the first person in Cachar to forward the proposal for the construction of Barak Dam. He will be remembered in the valley for the noble attempt he made to usher in a green revolution in the valley through the package program in the sixties when advanced technology, high yielding seeds, scientific manure, pesticides were introduced for the first time in Cachar. He died in AIIMS, Delhi at an age of 53 years in the year 1976.

About Lt. Sahidul Alom Choudhury



Sahidul Alom Choudhury was born on 13th December 1946 in a well known Choudhury family of Algapur in Hailakandi district of Assam. He was born to mother Samsun Nessa Choudhury and father Abdul Latif Choudhury.

He started his political carrier as a councilor from Algapur GP in the year 1977. He has been elected as a Member of Assam Legislative Assembly from Algapur Constituency as an independent candidate in the year 1985. Later, he joined the AGP and became a minister of state in the department of Municipal Administration in the first AGP government. In 1996, he became the minister for Panchayat and Rural Development when the AGP again came to power. He was an MLA till his death on 20th November, 2012. He has established many educational Institutions, including two Degree Colleges for access of education mainly for the students of remote areas of Hailakandi. It was under his leadership, Hailakandi was upgraded from a Sub-Division to a District in the year 1989.

Rules and Regulations

1. Attendance:

Student shall be required to attend not less than 75% of the aggregate of classes in order to be eligible to appear in the final examination. Attendance of the students shall be counted from the date of admission in the respective classes. If a student is found be continuously absent from the class without information for a period of 30 days or more his/her name shall be struck off the rolls.

2. Students discipline:

Every student of the college shall maintain discipline and consider it as his/her duty to behave decently at all places. Every student should carry his/her identity card issued by the Principal. Any student found guilty of impersonation and misconduct or misbehaviour of any nature with others shall be liable to disciplinary action. Causing damage, spoiling or disfiguring the property/equipment of the college will be strongly dealt with. Students found guilty of breach of discipline shall be liable to such punishment, as fine, campus ban, expulsion or rustication.

3. College Uniform:

Students without college uniform shall not be allowed inside the college campus. The sample of the cloths for college uniform will be provided by the college authority along with the prospectus at the time of admission.

Fees:

Fees for various courses & examination will be notified from time to time by the office of the Principal as per Govt. norms. All fees as announced by the College authority from time to time will have to be paid in due time failing which the authority may impose late fine or take any action as necessary. Exemption in admission fees to the BPL students will be provided as per the latest Govt. norms.
